- Volunteer activity as a space of interaction between religious organizations

- Theological view of the interaction between the church and the army

Three years of full-scale war and eleven years of Russia's hybrid aggression against Ukraine have led to the intertwining of the fates of two social institutions that were most trusted by the Ukrainian people - the Church and the Army. The interaction of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and religious organizations is the subject of the conference "Army and Church in Ukraine", which proposes to consider the problems and ways of their solution that have developed during the eleven-year confrontation between Ukraine and Russia.

Requirements for abstracts:

The title of the abstract in the middle of the line (in capital letters, Times New Roman font No. 14, bold).

Below, at one interval, in the center - the author's surname and initials, academic degree, academic title (if any), position, department, full name of the institution where the author studies or works, city, country; Times New Roman font size 14.

The text of the abstract should be single-spaced and meet the following requirements: A-4 format, margins: top, bottom, left, right - 2 cm, Times New Roman font No. 14, line spacing - 1.5.

The list of references (without repetitions) is made at the end of the text under the title "References", taking into account the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015 "Information and Documentation. Bibliographic reference. General Provisions and Rules of Compilation". In the text, footnotes are indicated by square brackets with the source number in the list and the page number (pages) separated by commas, for example: [7, c. 16].

Text size: up to 5 pages with a list of references.

Language: Ukrainian, English.
